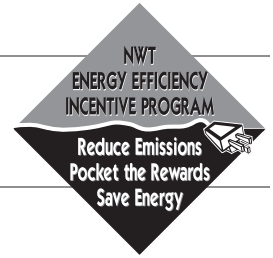

Heating Appliances Rebate

- \$900 – New ENERGY STAR® qualified oil furnace that has a 92.0% Annual Fuel Utilization Efficiency (AFUE) or better
- \$600 – New ENERGY STAR® qualified oil or gas boiler that has an 85.0% AFUE or better
- \$500 – New ENERGY STAR® qualified oil furnace that has an 85.0% AFUE or better, and a DC variable-speed motor (ENERGY STAR® rating will be changing to 87.0% in October 2008)
- \$300 – New ENERGY STAR® qualified oil furnace that has an 83.0% AFUE or better (ENERGY STAR® rating will be changing to 85.0% in October 2008)
- \$500 – New ENERGY STAR® qualified gas furnace that has a 92.0% AFUE or better, and a DC variable speed motor
- \$300 – New ENERGY STAR® qualified gas furnace that has a 90.0% AFUE or better
- \$250 – New oil furnace for mobile home with an AFUE of 80.0% or better
- \$400 – New wood burning appliance which meets either CSA - B415.1-M92 (performance testing of solid fuel burning heating appliances) or the US Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) wood burning appliance standards (40 CFR Part 60)
- \$500 – New pellet stove with ULC certification
- \$700 – New pellet furnace with ULC certification
- \$1,000 – Pellet boiler with ULC certification
- \$300 – New heat recovery ventilator that is certified by the Home Ventilating Institute (www.hvi.org)
- \$250 – Install a new instantaneous oil, gas or propane water heater that has an energy factor (EF) of 0.80 or better
- \$300 – Install a new condensing water heater that has an energy factor (EF) of 0.80 or better
- \$300 – New oil or gas domestic hot water heating system that meets CAN/CSA standards (in diesel or natural gas communities only – list of communities is available on AEA web site)

HOW THE REBATE WORKS (terms and conditions)

- Purchase** a qualifying heating appliance between September 15, 2008 and March 31, 2009.
 - The rebate is for energy efficient furnaces, boilers, wood stoves, pellet stoves, heat recovery ventilators and hot water heaters purchased by NWT residents.
 - Participating NWT retailers have the list of eligible appliances or check online at www.aea.nt.ca.
- Complete** the Application Form and attach a copy of the sales receipt.
 - Ensure the sales receipt (proof of purchase) clearly indicates payment in full, the amount paid, the date of purchase, and the make and model of the appliance.
- Mail, fax or deliver** the Application Form, a copy of the sales receipt and proof of residency to the Arctic Energy Alliance, #101, 5102-51st Street, Yellowknife, NT X1A 1S7. Fax (867) 873-0303.
 - The rebate application and sales receipt must be dated prior to April 1, 2009.
 - The Arctic Energy Alliance cannot be responsible for lost, late, incomplete or illegible submissions.
 - Please allow six weeks for delivery of your rebate cheque.
